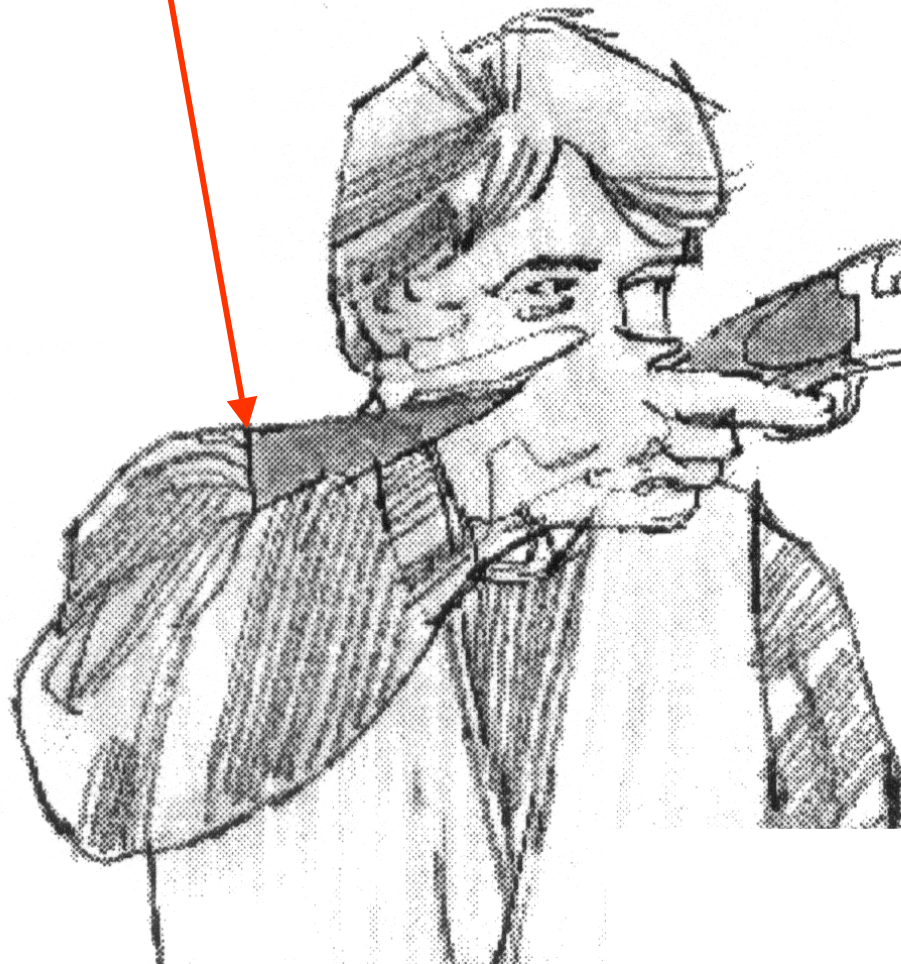
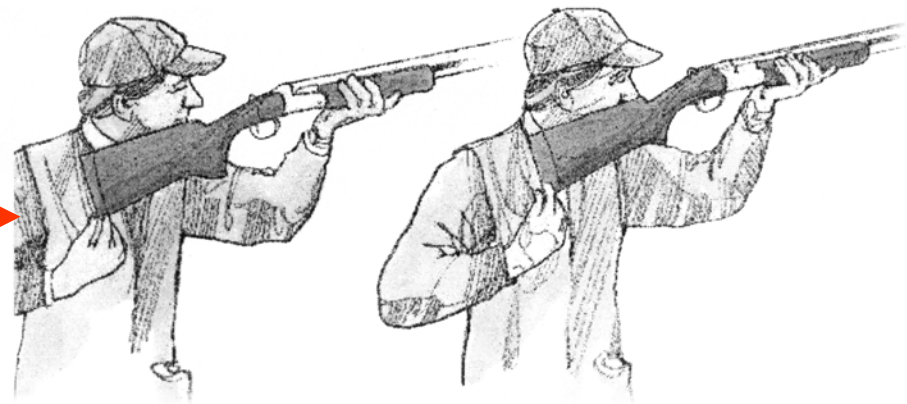
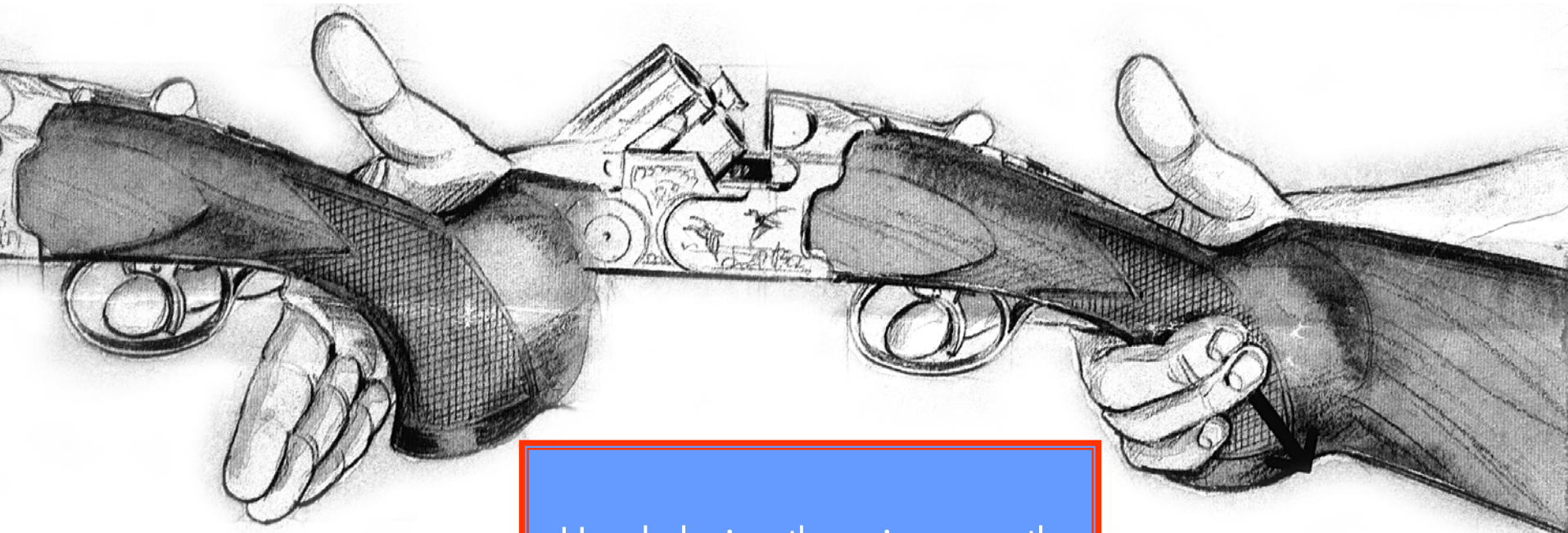


The heel should be level with the top of the shoulder (depending on the position of the shoulder pocket and depth of butt) although sometimes, certain shooting styles place the butt much lower in the shoulder

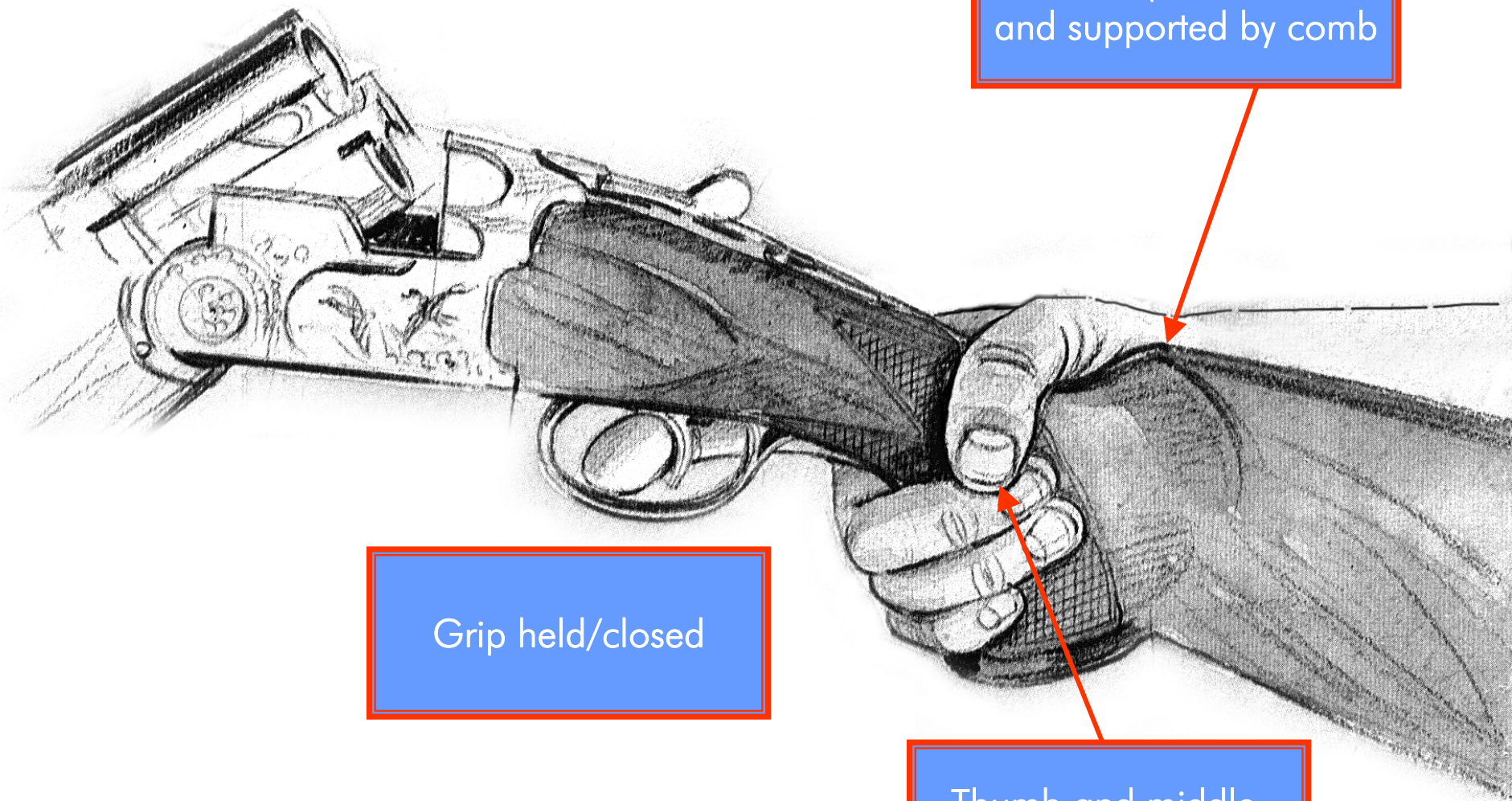


The right hand lifts, supports and places the butt into the shoulder and face

Note: the line through the hand and wrist into the forearm should be almost straight according to the shape and size of grip, allowing the wrist to be flexible and have freedom of movement



Hand closing the grip correctly



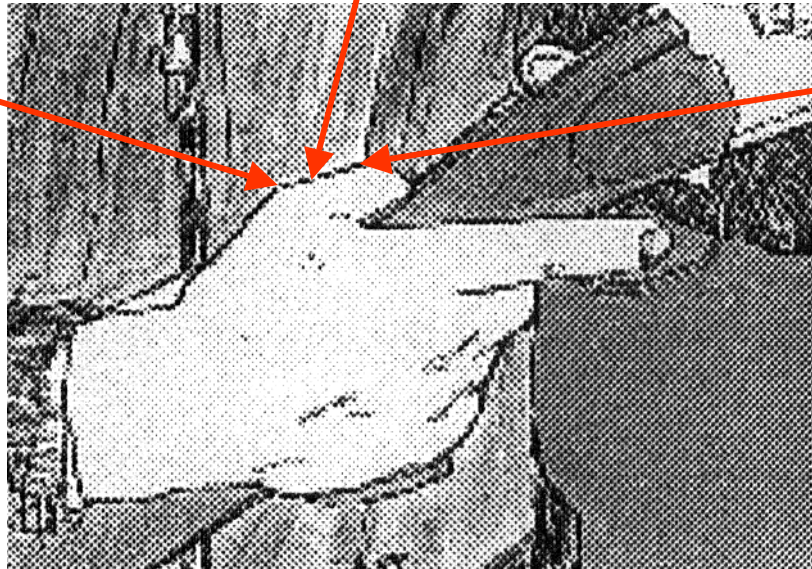
Thumb pulled back  
and supported by comb

Grip held/closed

Thumb and middle  
finger join

Thumb should lay across the grip

The hand "thumb joint"  
should be outside  
of the grip



The hand "nail joint"  
should be on the inside  
of the grip  
(on the body side)

The line from the top rib to the comb should  
intersect the thumb joint approximately mid-way  
between the two joints
